The Parties, by Counsel, seek the Court's approval to replace Exhibit 2 to the Settlement Agreement with the attached modified document. The modified notice is the postcard notice that will be sent to members of the Ruel 23(b)(3) class who disputed or inquired about a non-residential or high-risk address indicator. As modified, the notice clarifies to members of the Disputes Class that they can make a claim based on the nature and impact of their prior dispute, as opposed to the nature of the address identified by Experian which they disputed. Members of the Disputes Class are aware of their previous dispute as well as the address they disputed, and the Parties believe that the proposed edit to the Claim Form will clarify the basis for their class membership and any potential claim they might file, while omitting extraneous information that may cause confusion.

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What's this Case About? The lawsuit claims that Experian reported inaccurate information about some consumers' addresses through its Fraud Shield product. Experian denies it did anything wrong.

Am I Included? Based on Experian's records, you have been identified as a Settlement Class Member because between June 20, 2018 and July 31, 2021, you submitted an address-a dispute or inquiry to Experian regarding a non-residential or high-risk address indicator. while your Experian credit report contained a high risk or non-residential Fraud Shield Indicator. Experian reported the following address on your report as non-residential:

What does the Settlement Provide? The Settlement establishes a \$22,450,000 Settlement Fund for payments to Eligible Class Members after payments of attorneys' fees and expenses (not to exceed one third of the Settlement Fund), the Class Representative service payment of \$10,000, and administrative and notice costs. The Parties estimate you could receive between \$______ and \$_____, but this is just an estimate and is not guaranteed. The Settlement also establishes substantial and comprehensive changes to Defendant's business practices that will benefit all Class Members.

How Do I Get a Payment? You must submit a valid claim form <u>attesting to the nature of your dispute and that you</u> were harmed by Complete and mail in the attached claim form or file a claim online at www.FraudShieldSettlement.com.

Your Other Rights. Even if you do nothing, you will be bound by the Court's decisions. If you want to keep your right to sue Experian yourself, you must exclude yourself from the Settlement by Month 00, 2022. If you stay in the Settlement but do not agree with the terms, you may object to it by Month 00, 2022.

The Court will hold a hearing on **Month XX**, **2022** to consider whether to approve the Settlement, a request for attorneys' fees and expenses, and service payments. You or your lawyer may appear and speak at the hearing at your own expense.
