ORDER


This matter comes before the Court on Plaintiff Lisa Hill-Green's Joint Motion for Approval of Modification to Postcard Notice (the "Motion"). (ECF No. 131.)

In the Motion, Hill-Green requests the Court's approval to modify the postcard notices "that will be sent to members of the Ru[le] 23(b)(3) class who disputed or inquired about a non-residential or high-risk address indicator." (ECF No. 131, at 1.) She further states that "the [p]arties believe that the proposed edit to the Claim Form will clarify the basis for their class membership and any potential claim they might file, while omitting extraneous information that may cause confusion." (ECF No. 131, at 1.) Hill-Green submits that the Settlement Administrator has reviewed and approved the change. (ECF No. 131, at 1.)

Upon due consideration, and for good cause shown, the Court GRANTS the Motion. (ECF No. 131.) The Court DIRECTS the Clerk to file ECF No. 131-1 as an amended Exhibit 2 to the Settlement Agreement. (ECF No. 127-1.)

It is SO ORDERED.
